Bids will start closing at 5 PM on Wednesday Sept. 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 with Lot #1. Two lots will end every 1 Minute (120 Lots an hour) until all cataloged items have been sold. The auction should take between 2.5 hours to conclude. Each lot will have a scheduled ending time. If someone bids in the last minute and extra two minutes will be added to that lot to allow the back bidder time to bid again. It should be understood that the rest of the auction will continue to close as scheduled.

Let's say you are interested in Lot #120 the "Whatchamacallit". At any time after the Auction is uploaded onto the Proxibid's Online Server you could register, log in and place a bid on Lot #120. You will have the option of putting in a starting and maximum bid. Other bidders can bid on the same item at any time. Let's say the current bid is at \$500. If you bid the next increment of \$525 on the lot someone can come along and leave a bid of \$550 and knock you out. If you put a starting bid of \$525.00 and a maximum of \$2,000.00 the computer would bid for you up to your maximum bid. At 5 PM on 9/11/19 the items will begin to tick off, 2 lots every 60 seconds in the live auction. With 282 lots the auction will last about 2.5 hours. Say for example you put a starting bid on Lot #120 of \$525.00 with a Maximum of \$2,000.00. Let's assume there was competitive bidding during the several week period before the auction and the bid is up to \$1950.00. At Approx. 6:00 PM the lot will come up and show that it is ending. If someone bids \$2,000 it would show that they have been outbid and you would be put in for \$2,000.00. If they were to bid \$2050.00 that would exceed your maximum and you would be out. If this happened with 1 minute of the scheduled end time the computer would extend the bidding by 2 minute to allow you to bid. You would have to be online and logged into the auction to see this happen. This process will continue until one person stops bidding or doesn't bid before the time runs out.
